3. CLUB FINANCIAL REPORT

- Club started 2015 with \$15,196 and ended up with \$14,617. Essentially, breaking "even" for the year, but added a trailer and excess SWAG in a few of the races (RITS, Dino).

- EVENTS
- CHALLENGES
 - Volunteers:
 - The club runs on volunteers; our support by club members has been slowly going down
 - Club decided to re-instate from races for volunteers – volunteer to help at a race and earn a free race. Carlee will handle this duty
 - Race reporting / budget sheets (history)
 - Race results reporting to the club (for posting) has been absent for many races; we need to get race directors to begin posting results again
 - Managing the funds is an extremely important part to club operations. We need to develop a better process to fully account for all funds received and expended
 - There is very little history kept on the club; item up for discussion
 - Late sign ups, coordination with other events
 - We need to get people to start signing up early. Most used method is heavily discounted registration fees but even that is not working well. What other initiatives will help?
 - Group Runs & Club Travel
 - Very few regular group runs; need 10-12 people to make one a regular event
 - The Good The Bad and The Ugly Facebook group is working well (Tues nights and Fri evenings); Dan Waldron trying to start on Sunday mornings.
 - San Angelo Triathlon
 - Appears hiring a qualified race director is the primary option, but volunteers are still needed. Need to take this for action to work through with the SAT by January 2016
 - CDTR 2017; Carlee Price volunteered to take over race duties for the CDTR 2017; She will start working with Jeff Lisson, Adam & Marie Parker to learn the race.
 - RWB / SABA coordination
 - We used to be closer with SABA; SARL needs to continue to reach out and work with SABA. Partnering with some events will be a great way to help rebuild the relationship
 - Club events - races, socials, group runs

- Everyone is invited to come up with ideas for fun club events – BUT they will need to take the lead on it also
- Sponsor program (requests for race booths)
- We need to be careful when conducting races – we have organizations who have paid to sponsor the club – other organizations should not be allowed to set-up/display their wares at SARL events or we violate the trust of the sponsors. If those others would like to become an official sponsor of the club, then they can display their products

5. NEW BUSINESS

- Donations
 - Club voted \$2,000 to Sgt Korby Kennedy
 - Club voted \$4,000 to East Concho Volunteer Fire Department
 - Club will be polled via email to see if they would like to donate \$500 to student's ride across Texas
- 2016 Club Membership Program (Club membership, benefits, and dues)
 - RRCA Reporting requires us to maintain a club membership. It does not have to cost anything.
 - Club membership will be \$15 for the calendar year. T-shirts will be available for pickup at Randy's. April will manage membership and coordinate paid membership list w/ Randy.
 - Member T-Shirt is a way to show club unity; Club voted for a new light weight T-Shirt will be developed by Shane for the January Board Meeting.
- Replacement Race Directors
 - Crazy Desert Trail Run
 - Carlee Price voted to race direct the 2017 race; she will get in contact with Jeff Lisson to start learning the ropes
 - Club felt hiring the race out to for-profit companies that put on races – Trail Racing Over Texas, Tejas Trails, etc. is not needed.
 - Lake Nasworthy Tri: Yantis Green volunteered**
 - SAT: 501-3(C)
 - Club felt hire out RD to a for-profit companies might be best method to support this race
 - Volunteers for RD Duties (up to 6 needed) – will be needed whichever direction the SAT goes
